

Call for Nominations:
ASME Allan Kraus Thermal Management Medal, 2026
Nominations due by Sunday February 1, 2026 (11:59 PM US Pacific Time)



The Allan Kraus Thermal Management Medal recognizes an individual who has demonstrated outstanding achievements in field of thermal management of electronic devices and systems and for his or her commitment to the field of thermal science and engineering.

The nominee for the award should have significant contributions in thermal management of electronic systems demonstrated by successful product development, seminal papers, filed patents and/or leadership of research and development programs. The nominee must also have a high level of service accomplishments to the technical community at large.

The Thermal Management Award was established in 1994 by the [ASME Electronic and Photonic Packaging Division \(EPPD\)](#) and operated as a divisional award until 2009, when it was elevated to a Society Award and renamed as the ASME Allan Kraus Thermal Management Medal.

Any nominee that has gone through three cycles of the Award process will have to wait one year before a renomination. Incomplete nominations, or those submitted after the deadline will not be considered. Alan Kraus Committee members cannot nominate candidates, nor can they write letters of support.
