

## 2020 ASME C. D. Mote, Jr. Early Career Award

The Technical Committee on Vibration and Sound (TCVS) of the ASME Design Engineering Division solicits nominations for the 2020 C. D. Mote, Jr. Early Career Award. This award will be presented at the 2020 ASME Conference on Mechanical Vibration and Noise (VIB), a part of the ASME International Design Engineering Technical Conferences.

The <u>C. D. MOTE, JR. EARLY CAREER AWARD</u>, established in 2013, is presented to an early career recipient who demonstrates research excellence in the field of vibration and acoustics. In order to be eligible, candidates must be members of ASME for at least 3 years, be under the age of 40 years, or be within 10 years of their terminal degree. The date associated with the criteria is September 15 of the year the award is given. The recipient will receive a \$1500 honorarium, an award plaque. A maximum of three letters of support are required.

Nomination packages should include a letter of nomination, letters of support, the nominee's curriculum vitae, and other supporting documents, if any. All nomination packages must be submitted electronically in one single pdf file. The deadline for the receipt of nomination packages is April 1, 2020.
