## **Honors and Awards Executive**

The Honors and Awards Executive oversees and coordinates all honors and award activities for the Division and Technical Committees. The executive serves on the Design Engineering Division Executive Committee for a 3-year term with a possible 3-year extension. Key activities include:

- 1) **Managing the Call for Nomination**: Collaborate with the Division's and Technical Committee's nominating committees to initiate and promote the call for nominations.
- 2) **Review Nomination Materials**: Ensure all submitted nomination materials are complete and meet the required criteria.
- 3) Coordinating Award Evaluation and Selection: Facilitate the review process and winner selection by the designated award committee members.
- 4) **Reporting Evaluation Outcomes**: Communicate the results of the evaluation process to the ASME General Awards Committee for Society-level awards and to the Design Engineering Division Executive Committee for Division-level awards.
- 5) **Coordinating Award Production**: Oversees the production of award medals, plaques, and certificates to ensure timely and accurate delivery.
- 6) **Organizing Award Presentation Events:** Plans and manages the award presentation ceremony or banquet, ensuring a professional and celebratory experience for recipients.

The Honors and Awards Executive shall serve as Chairperson of the Divisions Honors and Awards Committee as well as Chairperson of the following Society level and Division level award committees (the Honors and Awards Executive does not participate in voting for winning selection; however, when there is a tie, the Honors and Awards Executive can use his/her vote to break the tie):
