At A Glance

- ASME undergraduate or graduate student members in good standing are eligible for academic scholarships.
- ASME student membership is required to login to the online application system. Join ASME or Renew your membership.
- Applicants must be accepted and later enrolled in Associate, Baccalaureate or graduate degree programs for the upcoming academic year starting in August/September. Associate degree programs at community/technical colleges or international programs holding Regional/National Accreditation are accepted. Baccalaureate programs at domestic colleges/universities must hold ABET accreditation.
- Complete only one application for all ASME Scholarships in this group.
- Students must apply again each year.
