

Due to the number of conference submissions, the help email lines will often become busiest close to conference deadlines.

Sending emails to many departments only creates backlog that takes staff longer to answer. It is best to send a backup email if you are concerned that your email didn't go through or you haven't gotten a response within 3 business days of your initial email.

Avoiding last minute submissions will allows time to address technical problems and resolve unexpected issues to ensure your submission meets conference requirements.
